Wednesday Preconference

Return to Work: What Do We Do Now? Putting the Puzzle Pieces Together

In this session our Vice President, Dianne Masiclat will share information from actual return to work cases she has managed over her many years of occupational health nursing experience. This will be an interactive session where you will participate in small groups and discuss strategies for these cases.

Come prepared to share about a case you have handled or may be handling now. This will be a great time to explore best practices. We learn the most from each other!

Thursday and Friday Conference

On Thursday speakers from Active Threat Trauma Care (ATTC) will provide medical training designed to empower responders with the capability to respond to traumatic injury in a crisis environment. They will share knowledge, skills, and techniques that were developed and proven in combat. The training is presented within the framework of an active-killer event.

This presentation will be informative, engaging, and is supported by breath-takingly real active bleeding task trainers and reality-based exercises that require trainees to make critical decisions, employ tactics, take the lead, and employ learned medical skills. The goal is to promote new life-saving techniques and empower all responders to save lives.

On Friday the opening session will be presented by our own Kathleen Buckheit who will recount the North Carolina IBM shooting from 1982. Speakers from Resources for Resilience will provide practical strategies to promote wellbeing in the face of ongoing stress or adversity. They will focus on how to reset the nervous system after it has been thrown out of balance by high stress or trauma.

Conference Learning Outcomes

- *Discuss the best practices for returning employees to work.
- *Demonstrate bandaging, victim movement, how to control the 3 types of hemorrhaging and how to care for penetrating chest and abdominal injuries.
- *Explain how to prepare for crises in the workplace that cause traumatic injuries.
- *Review practical strategies to promote wellbeing of others after a traumatic event.

This activity has been submitted to the Commission for Case Manager Certification and the Ohio Nurses Association (ONA) for approval to award 11 contact hours. ONA is an accredited approver of continuing nursing education by the American Nurses Credentialing Center's Commission on Accreditation.
